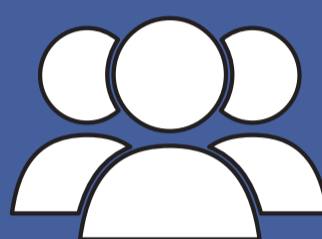

### Why integrate healthcare?



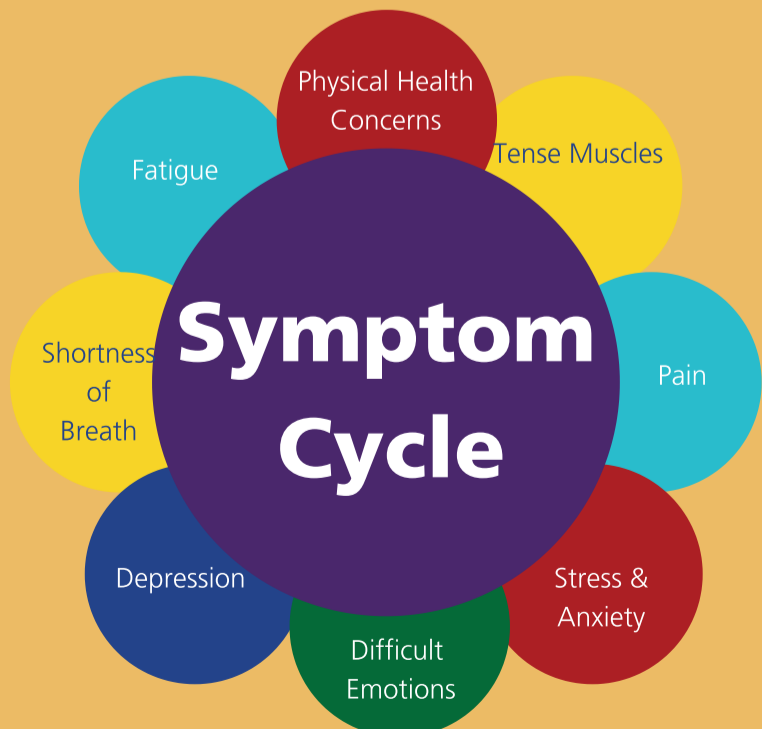

## 1935 JFCS FOUNDED

Jewish Family & Children's Service was founded by a group of courageous Jewish women looking to help people of the community during the Great Depression.

## 1955

**JEWISH FAMILY & CHILDREN'S SERVICE**  
 Becomes incorporated as a 501(c)3 nonprofit organization.

## 1966 ACCREDITATION

JFCS becomes the first social service organization to be accredited by both the Family Service Association of America and the Child Welfare League of America.

## 1975

### NEW LOCATION

JFCS moves in to 7th St. location, which will later be added along with additional service locations across the Valley.

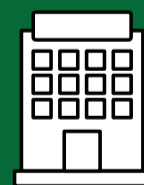
